Duties

Under the general supervision of the Data Processing Manager II (DPM II), responsibilities include:

- Oversee the development and maintenance of the Lottery's personal computing device technical environment, including the establishment of Group Policy Objects and related elements of the Lottery's Active Directory structure and automating processes to make the distribution of equipment and software as efficient as possible
- Diagnose and develop solutions to complex problems on the local area network servers including hardware or software failure of operating systems or vendor provided applications residing on the Windows Server based platforms and hardware
- Function as the subject matter expert for the desktop and laptop computers and provides third level support for the section
- Advise other Lottery staff on data storage and other server related subjects including managing new server installations, operating systems changes, software changes or hardware upgrades
- Develop comprehensive information technology strategies to meet the varied needs of the Lottery's staff located in the Headquarters facility as well as nine District Offices located throughout the State
- Provide technical project management leadership for the most complex desktop and mobile computing projects

Desirable Qualifications

Applicants applying for this position should have:

- Well developed skills including experience troubleshooting networks
- Have good customer service and interpersonal skills
- Have strong written and verbal communication skills
- Ability to handle multiple projects simultaneously
- The ability to work extended hours (overtime may be required)

Applicants must be state employees who are currently in the System Software Specialist II (Technical) classification or have current list or transfer eligibility to this class.
