### Duties

Under the direction of the Supervising Lottery Agent, responsibilities include:

- Independently conduct complex and sensitive criminal, civil and administrative investigations and collect information for the Lottery
- Investigate complaints and allegations of administrative misconduct of retailers, claimants, distributors, suppliers and contractors to the Lottery
- Conduct retailer on-site compliance checks
- Interview suspects and witnesses, work with informants, make arrests and testify in state and federal court as required
- Provide technical advice to local, state and federal law enforcement agencies to ensure integrity, honesty and fairness in the operation of the Lottery
- Provide physical building access for Lottery district offices and other security related to Lottery operations
- Assist with internal and new employee background investigations
- Fingerprint new Lottery retailers, contractors and employees

### Job Requirements

Applicants applying for this position must:

- Be proficient in computer systems and software
- Possess in-depth knowledge of investigative procedures and techniques and have an aptitude for evaluating information (including computer data)
- Use good judgment in handling sensitive and confidential material, which could otherwise result in information being lost and/or released to unauthorized persons
- Be POST certified or eligible for certification within 12-months of appointment date
- Be willing to work overtime and travel at any time (including out-of-state, overnight and national)

### Who Should Apply

Applicants should be state employees who are currently in the Lottery Agent classification, have transfer eligibility, or on a current eligible list for appointment to this classification. Applications will be screened and only those that best meet the requirements of the job will be considered. Appointment is subject to the provisions of SROA/Surplus.
